You have heard the rattling cry of liberty, the timbrel sound of democracy for which all present-day races and nations are working with the fullest hope and satisfaction. The sons and daughters of Africa are too many to allow themselves to be deprived of these valuable essentials to human happiness, human progress and human salvation. You must feel as a people that the privileges and opportunities enjoyed by others should also be enjoyed by you, in that Nature made you as heirs in common to this glorious Creation in which you find yourselves and in which you know no other master but the Creator.

In all things physical we are determined to master our own destiny and direct our own fate. In the things that are spiritual, we leave ourselves entirely to the will of God, but in the new philosophy we feel that if we must rise to heights of material glory, we must accomplish that only through our physical endeavors, and in that direction four hundred million Negroes are now bent under the leadership of the Universal Negro Improvement Association.

INSPIRING UNREACHED MILLIONS

Can I not inspire the millions who have not yet come in touch with this grand and glorious movement to now link up and join hands with us in carrying out the program of race emancipation and national redemption? May I not beseech the scattered sons and daughters of Ethiopia to rally to the glorious colors of the future African State—the Red, Black and Green? May I not point you to the hope of a new-born day, wherein the Negro shall see the light of his own future happiness and the glory of his own risen race. We need courage, we need greater manhood, a stronger manhood in our race, and we feel sure that the propoganda of the Universal Negro Improvement Association will so change the mind and heart of man as to make us all see things anew, see them with the vision of the prophet that in our own time and that of our posterity, we shall once more elevate ourselves to the height of national independence and imperialism that will make other men of other races see in us the character of their regard and respect, merited by our racial contribution to a progressive world.

The Negro at this time is called upon to evolve a new civilization and establish firmly a culture of his own. We must be original, we must be productive, we must be creative. There is room for the Negro to make his independent contribution to the affairs of men, and the Universal Negro Improvement Association believes that in Nature's good time we shall resurrect ourselves from the buried ages.

LET NOTHING DISCOURAGE

The white world may try to rob and discredit us of the things in history we claim as our own. They may tell us that the ancient civilization of Egypt and the Pharaohs was not of our race, but that does not make the truth unreal. Every student of history of impartial mind knows that the Negro once ruled the world, knows that the Negro once gave civilization to mankind, knows that when the white man knew not himself other than that he was a savage, a barbarian and a cave man, that the Negro stood at the very height of civilization. The proud Mussolini, mindful of his own, may prate of a part of the black man's Africa being "Italian forever," but that does not make it so.

Shall we lose hope because we were once slaves? Surely not. We shall, like the rest who have been slaves, like the Britons, lift ourselves from the state of degradation to the height of progress. As the British slave was able to redeem himself out of the fall of Rome, so will Africa and Africans, redeem themselves out of the fall of many of the waning powers of today.

Let us, therefore, as four hundred million people, look forward to a better time, the time when the Negro will no longer be a serf, but when he will be regarded as a full grown man, demonstrative of the best in the human race, capable of holding his own against all and sundry.

De'rious Democracy

(Columbian Press Bureau) WASHINGTON.—Wholly absorbed in sectional issues, during his recent speech in Congress permitting his judgment to be warped by prejudice and antipathies, and forgetful of the lesson he learned while a student of history at the University of Mississippi, Congressman Wilson, the Democratic Representative of the Sixth Mississippi district, in an intemperate, unwarranted and untimely tirade on Negro citizenship, scrapped the work of the Democratic leaders in New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois and Missouri, who are openly making overtures to colored males and females of voting age.

"Why should this administration try to do for the Negroes that which God Almighty did not do," said the Mississippi Democrat who malevolently declared, "The same divine power that created the lower order of animals created us. You can take a mule and curry him; you can shear his locks; you can even put 'stacombs' if you please, on his hair but by no human progress can you make out of him a Kentucky thoroughbred. The Negro bears the same relationship to the Caucasian race. The Negro race is an inferior race, as compared with ours, and why do some Republicans try to do something for him that God Almighty could not do?"

In his zeal to offend Negro citizens, Congressman Wilson forgot the history of Egypt, of Babylon—of Mizraim and Nimrod—both descendants of Ham, who, according to early historians, led the way and acted as pioneers of mankind in the various untrodden fields of art, literature, and science.

White Contributor Answers Some Queries on Africa

Resident in Africa Twenty Years, He Rejoices He Can Possess His Soul in Peace—Descants on 'Civilization's Gift'

To the Editor, Negro World: Dear Sir—I receive so many strange inquiries from America, disclosing such complete ignorance of West African life, that I am fain to answer this present mail's batch in detail.

What is Liberia like in comparison with America? I would need to fill a volume to answer such a wide-sweeping demand. Liberia has not an inch of railways and scarcely any motor roads.

When does the rainy season start? June, and lasts heavily until December. There are preliminary "little" rains in April. At the moment of writing we have not had a rainfall for fourteen weeks, and it is costing me two pounds (some ten dollars) a month for bathing, kitchen and drinking purposes, from the stream two miles away.

What about the two industries, farming and fishing? Both unorganized. The natives grow enough yams, Indian corn, cassava, etc., for own use; but there is still a big import of Indian rice, flour, stock fish, etc.

even when the moon is bright enough to read by! Baths and water supply? Again, how? I have a large iron bath, enamelled, and with pipes and taps. At Lagos I paid a water rate and could turn on the water night and day as needed. Here we have no reservoirs or water supply at all, and all my water comes from a tributary of the Niger. It is carried by "head."

Telephones in the house? Thank the powers, there isn't a telephone in the district! We commercials were asked if we would like a system and would pay for it. We all declined. We can do our interchange of views by "chit." And we are not inclined to have irritating calls when we are doing something else. Dam telephones! They are the nightmare of American life!

How much is land? Well, the land belongs to the African population; and we whites (British though we are) are merely the guardians and protectors of the African people. Hence no white man can purchase land. Impossible to acquire freehold. No doubt, incoming American Negroes, by taking out papers of nationality with the Nigerians, might be more privileged than we are. We have a Native Lands Acquisition Ordinance, under which we can rent for 10, 20 and up to (about the limit) 30 years, at a nominal £4 to £40 an acre, according to soil.

The late Lord Leverhulme nearly had a fit of apoplexy in his rage against these barriers to "commercialization" of the colony. He said that Great Britain was standing in the way of progress; but the rulers advise a policy of Festina Lente, and they say they are not going to see the African "dragged" into a culture for which he is unprepared.

Already the native is suffering, just as the South Seas native has suffered! Civilization's gift is worth NOTHING—and its curse is sadness, strain and self-distress!

Read my poem, "The Black Man's Burden"; and remember that behind everything I write for the NEGRO WORLD is a serious meaning!

What kind of car? Well, we have good roads here (different from Liberia!); and we generally use Fords. The "divver" is everywhere, and even comparatively poor natives either own or share one.
