LET'S PUT IT OVER

THE YAWP OF THOSE WITHOUT VISION

PLACE a light on and not under a bushel measure and it cannot be hid. When a man rises above his fellows there will always be many to envy him and seek to pull him down from his high place.

Marcus Garvey has raised up more enemies and yawpers who can see no good thing in him or anything that he has done than any other man of his times. The very fact that he has raised them up, and that they stick to their dirty job, is the best possible evidence that Mr. Garvey has done something worth while which they could not do.

The troubles between white Presidents and our vital bodies have been much in evidence during the past few years, with Howard, Shaw, Fisk and Lincoln universities leading the procession. In settling the troubles of Fisk and Lincoln universities the trustees made a mistake in selecting white men to take the places of the white men around whom the troubles gathered, and they have only postponed the day of more troubles and the election of Negro Presidents.

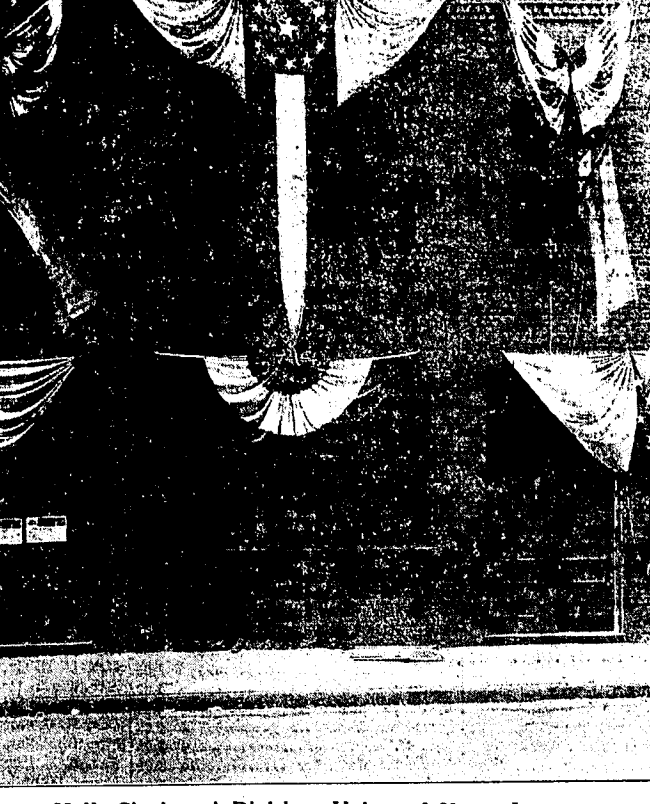

BRAZIL RESIGNS, LEAGUE AGHAST

Geneva in Plans of Brazil, News-Items: The Brazilian more comes as a blow by a similar action by Spain, as both nations have been in the same way, with Spain announcing categorically that she refuses to be classified as a secondary Power, which would mean a permanent seat on the League of Nations.

GENEVA, Switzerland, Monday.—Brazil has resigned from the League of Nations. Notification of this step received by cable today from Foreign Minister Pacheco at Rio Janeiro, caused consternation in League circles.

The withdrawal follows her earlier act in resigning from the League Council because of the refusal of the Powers to grant her a permanent seat simultaneously with Germany, who she pointed out at the League conference.

League officials, having their opinion on Ambassador Melo Franco's speech, in which he said he would resign the League Council, are confident that the Rio government would not take the final step until the League officials had had the opportunity to try diplomatic negotiations.
