Negroes Must Discard the Propaganda of Alien Races and Promote a Racial Character Of Their Own

Fellow Men of the Negro Race, Greeting:

It is gratifying to see and realize how wonderfully well our people are throwing off the psychology of alien races and promoting a racial character of their own.

For quite a long while the members of other races tried to enslave us by a false psychology and a vicious propaganda. They tried to make us see life and all things from their point of view, and they succeeded to the extent that they nearly made permanent slaves of all of us; but, fortunately, you cannot "fool all of the people all of the time," because to us is born in this age a new type of men who are determined to cast off the psychology and propaganda of the other fellow and husband that of their own.

The great white man has succeeded in subduing the world by forcing everybody to think his way, from his God to his fireside. He has given to the world, from the Bible to his yellow newspaper sheet, a literature that establishes his right and sovereignty to the disadvantage of the rest of the human race.

The white man's propaganda has made him the master of the world, and all those who have come in contact with it and accepted it have become his slaves.

The Universal Negro Improvement Association is calling upon the 400,000,000 members of our race to discard the psychology and propaganda of all other peoples and to advance our own. The white man taught that the best of the world was intended for him, and we now teach that all the beauties of creation are the black man's, and he is heir to all that God has given to man.

"A White World"

The white man sees a white world and propagates his doctrines accordingly. The black man now sees a black world and teaches that to his race of all generations.

Above the noise and shout of the world there should be one ringing cry, that of "Africa for the Africans," at home and abroad. Then we should also insist on seeing all things black to the exclusion of all other matter. So long as Englishmen are going to talk about England and Frenchmen of France and white Americans of America, then there is nothing left for us to do but think and talk of black Africa, the preaching of the Christian missionary notwithstanding.

We must meet propaganda with propaganda and not let up until those who lead in the selfishness of race demonstrate the real brotherhood of man that they have been telling the world about for nearly 2,000 years.

The Negro is now accepting the religion of the real Christ, the Christ of Love, Justice and Mercy. The Negro wants no more of the white man's religion as it applies to his race, for it is a lie and a farce; it is propaganda pure and simple to make fools of a race and rob the precious world, the gift of God to man, and make of it the exclusive home of pleasure, prosperity and happiness for those who have enough intelligence to realize that God made them masters of their fate and architects of their own destinies.

The Negro's love for Christ and the Christian religion is beyond question, but we simply refuse any longer to accept the interpretation of the white man on those fundamentals that seek to elevate or establish the rights of man. The white leader has failed to impress the world of today with his honesty of purpose. He is only a propagandist, and the black race has had enough of his propaganda and wants no more of it.

NEGRO VOTES THAT DO NOT COUNT

Another election of men and women to represent the varied interests of the citizenry in the Congress of this republic has passed into history. The Negro, representing one-tenth of this citizenry, returned from the polls a heavy loser, as has always been the case with him in national politics. This may account for the gloominess of our Christian friend, Prof. Kelly Miller, who, in one of his recent releases to the Negro press, reached the conclusion that, as a political factor, the Negro had ceased to exist.

Considering the race our political bosses and advisers begin by pointing us to the influence exerted in Congress in our behalf by "our comrades" of the white race, and beseeching us to trust to their guidance for deliverance from national prejudice and political defeat. The Negro must not be misled by these causes and endeavor to make an honest attempt to eradicate them. Few warn us that we must search with diligence far and wide if we would find true and trusted white politicians whom we may sincerely term "our comrades."

PECULIAR LESSON ON HOW TO GROW BY A MISSIONARY

Liberia Will Prosper by Embracing Exploitation, Says White "Reverend"—President King a "Real Negro"—Sp. Thinks South Carolina

Prior to embarking for Belgium to attend an international conference at Brussels on matters concerning the Republic of Liberia, the Rev. Herbert A. Donovan, Protestant Episcopal minister, gave an interview at the Hotel Pennsylvania, where he had been stopping since his arrival in New York.

The greatest problem in Liberia at present, he says, is whether the republic is to be allowed to develop on the basis of its own commonwealth or continue to be rather a vassal to powerful nations. At present, he says, England on one side and France on the other have cut down the territory of the country until it is little larger than the State of New York.

"President King is a real Negro," said Mr. Donovan, "and in automatic, as he has to be, in a country where the trouble is that he is greatly hindered in his program by opposition from other nations as well as the stupid native element.

"For instance, he favors the granting of a 50-year lease for a million acres to the Firestone Corporation, feeling that while the company is exploiting the rubber industry of the country it will also be developing the land and furnishing capital by which the republic can become more important.

"Personally, I feel this would be the wisest thing the Liberians could do. They have had a republic over one hundred years and yet the prevalence of ignorance and backward conditions is surprising. I contend that the United States makes a mistake in leaving the natives to fend for themselves. If America had not abandoned interest in the republic about 1847 much harm could have been avoided.

"Africa is becoming more and more important to the United States. More than a passive interest in Liberia the natives might be enabled to set up their own government. They have no schools or churches to speak of now and their young men, with a few exceptions, are unlearned and utterly incapable. I am anxiously waiting to see what we accomplish at the international conference in Belgium."

THE NATIVE PAST SYSTEM What Africa's Sons Have to Endure at the Hands of Decadent Portuguese in Their Own Africa

(From the "Beira News," Portuguese East Africa)

New passes for natives are about to be issued in the Territory, and they are of a design which is a distinct advance upon the systems commonly used elsewhere in Africa. The most striking feature of the new pass is that it is enclosed in a neat and strong aluminum case which will protect the booklet which forms the pass from dirt and grease which make a native pass such an unpleasant object to use. The information to be inserted in the pass is most comprehensive and includes a photograph of the holder as well as his finger prints, his name, parent name, racial characteristics and his design as a worker on the estate or on the third page. Eight passes are issued for three months and are renewed by the holder's principal, if any, and the next page records his work. Returning alumni are urged to register in the Alumni Office just as soon as possible upon arriving in Washington, where they will deposit their railroad certificates for validation. On Wednesday they will be provided with guides who will conduct them on an inspection tour of the campus buildings and grounds.

A visitors' directory will be maintained in the Alumni Office for the convenience of all who may desire to ascertain the whereabouts of visiting alumni with whom they may want to get in touch. The directory will contain the local as well as the home address of visitors, together with their Washington telephone numbers.

On Wednesday, the 24th, Dr. and Mrs. Johnson will greet informally any returning alumni who may wish to call at the home of the President.

On Wednesday night at 8 o'clock in the University Chapel, there will be a "Homecoming" service. Urban Environment Affects Both Races Similarly

WASHINGTON, Nov. 12.—Black and white alike are being affected by the urban environment, according to a study by Professor Jerome Davis, sociologist of the University of Oklahoma, in his book "The Negro in American Life," in which he traces the progress of the Negro in the United States.

Tracing Chicago as a base, Professor Davis states that it is no more attractive to Negroes than it is to white criminals, each alike being influenced by the congested urban life and the general environment.

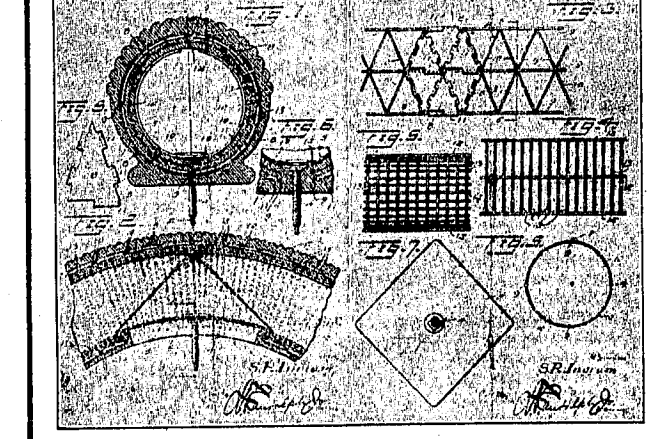

THE WEST INDIES SEEK SALVATION BY FEDERATION

Islands Urged to Cast Off Foolish Ideas and Unite for the Common Good—America Furnishes Excellent Example.

The October number of The Jamaica Critic, commenting on the West Indian Conference, held in London in May and June this year, says in part:

And now what are we aiming at, what do we expect from these future conferences? For one thing, we expect that the bonds which have already cemented friendship between members of the different delegations will be extended to bring all the British West Indian Islands together.

SOME RARE FINDS IN EGYPTIAN TOMB

Harvard Investigator Uncovers Treasures of Fourth Dynasty

CAIRO, Nov. 10.—Dr. George A. Reisner, assistant professor of Egyptology of Harvard University, has issued a report describing the work he has done on the tomb of Queen Neferephes, mother of King Cheops and wife of Senefere, first sovereign of the fourth dynasty. The report said that identification of the tomb is based on two inscriptions in gold hieroglyphics on the back of a carrying chair.

Dr. Reisner found evidence that Neferephes died some time after Cheops came to the throne and was buried at Dashur, on the west of the Nile and directly south of the great pyramids. The tomb was rifled by thieves, and when the violation was discovered Cheops's secretary transferred the body to a new tomb at the entrance of the pyramid Ghiza. This tomb is a vertical shaft cut 100 feet through the limestone, with the chamber opening from the bottom. Every-thing in the former tomb was brought out, even the things the thieves had smashed.

The discoveries included a bed and three chairs, still intact; fifty implements and tools, six of which are solid gold, fifteen copper and the others flint; a dozen wooden panels with inlaid floral designs in falcon, framed in gold; household vessels, including three gold cups, a copper basin, a ewer, twenty-eight alabaster vessels and five boxes of linen, almost entirely disintegrated.

Many of the vessels found represent the traditional types of the third dynasty. Perhaps the most impressive discovery was a gold cased jewel box bearing the Queen's name and containing twenty silver anklets, graduated to fit the leg upward. Each anklet is ornamental with four conventionalized dragon flies inlaid with calcite, lapis lazuli and cornelian.

Dr. Reisner has now begun to remove the canopy and sarcophagus with the palens bearing the name of Senefere. The canopy's framework is an astonishing piece of work. All the ligons and mortices are sheathed with copper. It has copper attachments for curtains or doors. The sarcophagus will probably be opened in December.
