## The Day and Opportunity of the Negro Is Approaching; Be Prepared to Take Your Stand As Men

Fellow-Men of the Negro Race, Greeting:

The war clouds of Europe are once more gathering, and it is most likely that at any time a Continental conflict will break out and force through the militaristic tendencies and designs of Europe, which will ultimately engulf the world in another holocaust.

It is for such a time that the four hundred million Negroes of the world are preparing themselves, when the opportunity will be presented to strike the blow in Africa for our liberation. It is hoped that Negroes everywhere will prepare themselves for the time when they will be called upon to stand together as one mighty whole to blast a way toward those changes that are desired by us universally. Critics have speculated as touching the program of the Universal Negro Improvement Association, claiming how impossible it will be for us to accomplish the things that we have set out to do, but all reasonable minds can see and readily admit that the changes that will bring about better conditions among Negroes will not so much be instigated through war by the Negro himself as by the very people who have robbed, exploited and killed us for hundreds of years. The great Colonial governments of Europe will of themselves strike the blow by which the four hundred million Negroes of the world will be made free, and Europe is just lining up for such a contingency, as is evident to all.


Let us get ready, let us organize now more than ever for the putting over of the program of the Universal Negro Improvement Association. We want victory, and we must have it. We want a government of our own, and we must have it. We want freedom, true liberty, real democracy. We must have all these things. It is not a question of whether the other fellow is going to give it to us under his government or not; it is a question that we must go out and possess ourselves of that which we desire.

The only way we can have real freedom is when we, by our own effort, have laid out the foundation of a great government that we ourselves will control. For such an opportunity, I repeat, we wait, and may God hasten the day. Let Mussolini rave, let Germany clamor for African soil, and then in a short while we will see Europe so ablaze it will take more than human effort to smother the flames. Europe is fast gravitating to her doom. The nations of Europe have seen their day and time. Like Rome, they will crumble and fall to pieces, and as in the fall of Rome came the resurrection of other empires and mighty nations, with the fall of the present monarchistic, capitalistic and despotic empires of Europe will come the resurrection of a great African State upon which the sun will never set.

Let the members of the Universal Negro Improvement Association take new courage for 1927; let us work with greater determination because victory is sure to perch upon our banners. Harken not to the critics within and without, because their voices soon will be stilled.

There is one thing about us: we are determined. If it takes eternity, we shall win our cause. Therefore, time does not mean much to us. It is the principle, it is the object to be realized, and for that we work day in and day out without ceasing. Surely the rank and file of the Universal Negro Improvement Association cannot be discouraged, caring not how difficult be the time, how relentless be the propaganda against us. Traitors will come and traitors will go, but remember this: the principles of the Universal Negro Improvement Association will go on forever. We shall forget the traitors as we march on to victory, we shall forget the men who tried to embarrass us on our march to the promised land.

Godliness in Africa

(The following is the fifth installment of a remarkable address delivered at the President's Meeting of the African Committee League, London, recently by Mr. J. B. Danquah, a Gold Coast student in London.)

While the missionary was shedding the Christian light on the African, there came with him something else. Invariably the flag of his European home came with him. In 1875 Europe held only about one-tenth of Africa; today, with the doubtful exceptions of Egypt and Liberia and perhaps the certain exception of Abyssinia, the whole of Africa is under the control and power of Western European nations.

After the first great shock of losing their leader for a time, members of the Universal Negro Improvement Association settled down to patience and forbearance to carry on until his return.

His sudden and unfair imprisonment commanded the attention of many who before had not given much time to the study of the aims and objects of the organization.

Thousands are asking why he continues to be incarcerated. From pulpit and press come expressions commending his work and deploring his imprisonment.

Partitions signed by thousands of loyal American citizens, members and non-members of the Association, have been forwarded to Washington praying for his release.

THE white race, as a group, has been ever friendly toward Marcus Garvey and the Universal Negro Improvement Association.

Release him. He has done no wrong. His imprisonment can accomplish nothing. He has been punished enough. His influence is wholesome and his return will favor his release.

Restricted Immigration Spur to Nationhood

To the Editor of The Negro World: Another death blow has been struck at the Negro by the recent laws enacted in the republics of Panama and Mexico restricting or barring more Negroes off their soil. The great economic depression that is now raging in Cuba and from which those of our race are the principal sufferers warrants our attention, as that also cannot be ignored. Needless to say that the latter country is also doing its best to bar West Indian Negroes from entering.

The policy which those two countries have adopted is worthy of great attention. Where we are concerned the question is vital. The Nordic (sic) of Europe and America, including the hybrids of the Latin countries, are all bent upon exterminating the Negro. Are all Negroes conscious of the fact that it is really so? It is rather deplorable to admit that there are Negroes who have not seen the gravity of the situation; others have seen but refuse to accept the evidence.

But there came a man eight years ago, a man who had foreseen the dreadful time we are experiencing today; a man with mind magnanimous, a student of psychology, a disseminator of knowledge, a man whose moral dignity commands the respect of the world. This very man launched a program of a no narrow magnitude, a program not only to temporarily alleviate our suffering conditions, but to obtain complete emancipation and perpetual freedom—a freedom not to be enjoyed in Europe nor in Latin-America, but in Africa, our God-given land, the land where our liberties will be no more restricted.

We are all surprised at the attitude adopted by the government of Panama toward the Negro—the Negro who was indispensable and instrumental in making the Panama Canal what it is today. But we are not vexed with that government, for their action will serve to give more impetus to those of us who have already grasped the situation, and will cause the Negroes that still live in that state of lethargy to join the Universal Negro Improvement Association.

For Australia, Canada, Mexico and Panama, made safe for Northerners; for the fact that British West Indians are classed as aliens in England, and also that the immigration restriction of the United States means to Negroes keep out, and notwithstanding the dirty attitude of a few disgruntled members of our race, we cannot but otherwise work with an inflexible determination, zeal and earnestness, faith, courage and hopefulness onward to meet the ever-heaping obligations of the Cause that we all so dearly love—the Cause that will place the Negro in the heaven of happiness.

Improving Negro Family Life

WASHINGTON, Nov. 27.—Increasing attention is being given Public Health conditions among colored citizens on the part of national and state agencies. The national voluntary agency dealing with the control of venereal diseases is the American Social Hygiene Association, with headquarters in New York City.

For several years this organization has included in its national program serious consideration of these conditions as they relate to our racial group. The Association is some thirty years old and has four departments: Medical, Social Protection, Legal and Educational, and the work has received gratifying co-operation from colored leaders. One of its significant efforts aside from the specifically entered medical work has been to the problem of sex education. The most progressive Negro educational institutions under the guidance of this association are greatly correlating sound sex educational information in the curricula, the result of which will be a continually improving family life. Mr. Franklin O. Nichols, one of the outstanding men of the race, has had the responsibility of developing the educational program of this work, under the direction of the Association, among the people of his racial group. INOCULATE DOGS AGAINST RABIES

Health Board to Immunize City's Canine Population—Something Entirely New

The old wheeze about dogs biting men and men biting dogs was given a new twist when it was learned that Health Commissioner Harris is laying plans to make dogs immune to bites inflicted upon one another.

The plan is to inoculate all the canines of New York in such a way that it will be impossible for them to contract rabies. With this danger eliminated the dogs can run around biting to their heart's content without causing any more damage than lacerations and abrasions. Dr. Harris stated that he intended to call a conference of physicians and veterinarians in the near future to devise ways and means of carrying out his idea. In deciding upon this step, he said, he was influenced by the increase in the number of dogs suffering from rabies in the metropolitan district.

Another factor in his decision was the death of John Milbrandt, 10 years old, of 80 Merrick road, Jamaica, as the result of being bitten by a mad dog while playing in the yard of his home on August 14. The lad died in Kingston Avenue Hospital on October 23rd.

During the first six months of last year twenty-five cases of rabies were discovered in the examination of 152 dogs, the Health Commissioner stated, and in the same period this year 200 cases of rabies were found in the examination of 395 dogs.

Discuss Race Problem

WASHINGTON, Nov. 27.—Eighteen colored and thirty-two white women were brought together at the International Conference of Church Women, held at Eagles Mere, Pa., recently. According to the report of the Commission on the Church and Race Relations, the conference marked a new stage of progress in grappling with interracial problems by religious forces.

"The program included such topics as experience in interracial work among women, conditions of white and colored women in employment, concrete methods of work in race relations, problems of housing segregation in cities, and the question of what church women can do to create wholesome racial attitudes."

The report further states that there was a spirit of comradeship fostered by the informal contacts which prevailed during the development of the program. Tension between northern and southern white women, which frequently develops when they meet to discuss the race problem. Furthermore, the fear and suspicion which colored women have of a reactionary sentiment generally expected from the white women, did not determine the attitude of all the women assembled. The dominant attitude of all the women seemed to be liberal, democratic and Christian.

The necessity for interracial thinking before interracial action was emphasized by the conference which outlined several specific measures and appointed a continuation committee to proceed with promotional plans for getting its suggestions and program of work adopted by local groups of church women among local, denominational and community interracial groups.—C. P. B.

INFLUX OF ITALIANS ALARMS SOUTH FRANCE

Immigrants Buying Up All Available Land—Mussolini's Hand Is Seen

TOULOUSE, France.—The rapidity with which Italian immigrants are absorbing all the available land in this region, particularly in the departments of Gers and upper Garonne, is causing grave uneasiness among the French inhabitants. It is stated, and generally believed here, that Benito Mussolini, the Italian Premier, has formed a vast program of immigration, involving the settling of 500,000 Italians in the south of France within the next five or six years.

These colonists are not by any means all poor laborers. Many are well-to-do and of good family and pay cash for the farms they purchase. But rich or poor, all are carefully supervised by the Italian Government, which takes every precaution against their being assimilated by the French. There is at Toulouse an Italian Consulate with a staff of forty, an Italian bank and an Italian post office, to minister to the spiritual needs of the colonists. Many of the towns and villages have Italian schools and stores kept by Italians to cater to their countrymen.

Japan Builds Railroad To Compete With Soviet

TOKIO.—Work has been started upon the construction of the third railroad in Manchuria financed by Japan, which will be in direct competition with the Russian controlled Chinese Eastern Railway.

Bach Called Fanatic In His Early Days

Johann Sebastian Bach, one of the greatest of musical geniuses,—was at one time a piano tuner, and it was through his efforts that music reached its present range. Before Bach's time musicians had only a limited number of keys in which to write music, as they could not time their instruments to other keys, and as a result all music written prior to 1700 is very much alike in tone, says the Detroit News. Bach labored ceaselessly on the harpsichord, forerunner of the piano, until he discovered the lost notes hidden in the strings. Then he began to write music in keys hitherto unknown to his compatriots. At first they did not take kindly to his variations of chords and intermingling of many strange sounds, and called him a musical fanatic. Later, however, Mozart, upon hearing one of Bach's pieces, exclaimed, "Thank heaven! here at last is something new that I can learn from." Then followed such great masters as Chopin, Schumann, Liszt and Rubinstein, who adored and played Bach.
