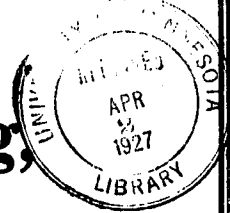

## Africa, Peculiarly Qualified By Experience and Suffering, Will Some Day Lift A Sinful World from The Mire of Materialism



**Hon. Marcus Garvey in Speech That Caused Sensation in Washington Expounds the Philosophy of the New Negro in His Climb to Nationhood—Wants Jesus but Also His Share of the World's Goods—Even as It Was a Black Man Who Came to the Help of Jesus on the Road to the Cross, So Negroes Will Fill the Role of the Good Samaritan to Stricken Humanity**

We print below the fourth instalment of a remarkable address delivered by the Hon. Marcus Garvey, founder and President-General of the Universal Negro Improvement Association, at Washington, D. C., on November 20, 1921:

"I am determined Africa shall play a similar part in the world as Europe and Asia. If I live for one hour longer, if I live for fifty years longer, if I live for one hundred years more, my one fight in the world shall be for a free and redeemed Africa. Now, do not call me a militarist, a warrior—I am just what the other fellow is. Understand that. If he is a Christian, I am a Christian; if he is anything else, I am just what he is, because I am satisfied to go anywhere he goes. I am not one of those Negroes who believe that the white man should take the world and give me Jesus. I am not one of those crazy Negroes who believe that. Jesus does not belong to the black man, to the white man—He is for all of us, whether white, yellow or black. So any man who thinks he is going to get all of Jesus, to the exclusion of every other man, is making a big mistake. Jesus is for everybody; therefore, I do not want all of Him. I only want my portion, my part of Jesus, and let the other fellow get his. But even as I am determined that he should get his portion and I mine, I want my portion of the world or I shall die for it. That old-time subserviency of the Negro, going down on his hands, of supplicating and begging, you have to cut that out. The first thing to decide is whether you are men. Are you men? If you are men, live like men, and it is preferable to die rather than live less than men. I believe with Patrick Henry: 'I care not what others may say, as for me give me liberty or give me death.'

"Africa is the rising star among the nations of the world. To me Africa in another fifty years, in another one hundred years, will be the leader of civilization. And why do I say so? Because the Negro, who is the African, has had an experience, an education never possessed by any other race of the world. We have had an education of five hundred years that ought to teach us how to live, how to govern, how to rule. No race has suffered such as this race of ours. By our suffering we are able to appreciate the sufferings of others, and thereby when we get into power we will be able to mete out justice and mercy because of what we ourselves felt when we were suffering. I cannot see how Negroes can be satisfied to have other people lead them. The only man who can lead me is the man who feels like me. The only man who can represent me is the man who suffers like me because that man knows what I want. No man who does not feel like me can tell me what I want. He cannot appreciate the extent of my suffering and, therefore, cannot represent me. And that is why the Universal Negro Improvement Association refuses to allow anyone to speak for the Negro but the Negro himself.

### *Africa's Quality of Mercy*

"I believe Africa will be the greatest nation in the world, because Africa with all the experience of centuries will be able to fathom the suffering of humanity, and Africa is always sympathetic, always merciful. Aye, we have practiced down the ages. When the world sought the life of the Son of God, when the whole world turned down the Son of God, who came to preach salvation to mankind, to preach redemption to the world, when Asia and Europe rejected Him, when Asia and Europe sought the life of God in the person of Jesus Christ, it was the love of Africa that saved Him for Calvary. From the cradle to the grave Africa stood beside the Son of God. When Herod sought the Child's life, the angel said, 'Flee, take the Babe into Egypt, the land of Africa.' And when that Child went back to Palestine, look what they did. They cried out, 'Crucify Him, crucify Him, crucify Him.' And they would not stop until the sentence of crucifixion was delivered. Crucify Him! And even up to the time when they placed upon the shoulder of the Son of God the heavy cross and they saw it was too much for His physical strength to bear, what did they do? They flogged Him, they pierced His Side, they lashed Him as he tried to climb the heights of Calvary. And there again Africa came to His rescue in the person of Simon, the Cyrenian, who took up the cross and bore it up the heights. There again the charity, the love, the mercy of Africa are exemplified, and I believe in another twenty-five years the wise ones will be telling us Simon the Cyrenian was a white man; but we are going to tell them later on the truth of history, because we are going to write our own history. We are going to give to the world our own revised version of the Bible, so that all that these counterfeiters have put in the Bible about colored men, black men, Negroes being created to be hewers of wood and drawers of water, will be cut out.

"We are living in a new day, in a new civilization, and it is for the Negro to carve out his own fame, his own destiny and send down the ages to succeeding generations."

Yes, the Race Will Not Miss Messrs. King and Borno

Haiti and Liberia, under the short-sighted leadership of Presidents Borno and King, respectively, furnish Negro-robbers with food for destructive criticism. Here is another South African morsel, culled from the report of a European-Bantu conference in Cape-town, South Africa.

"In support of his contention that the native races were unable to rise in intelligence above the white races, Mr. Russell mentioned the two native republics of Haiti and Liberia. Haiti had steadily retrograded for 125 years, and had deteriorated into a military despotism. Liberia, in spite of the fact that it was founded by liberated slaves, today practiced slavery. It is necessary for the European race to rule in South Africa," added Mr. Russell, "but we must rule the Bantu race with justice. Direct representation of the Bantu people in Parliament is essential." He suggested that the Bantu themselves should be eligible for the position as representatives of their people."

Progress of Negroes Unequaled in History, Says Senator Walsh

NEW YORK, March 28.—United States Senator David I. Walsh of Massachusetts praised the progress of the Negro race and expressed the opinion that its racial problems would find solution in education, in his address yesterday at a mass meeting for the support of the Cardinal Gibbons Institute, at Public School 96, 225 West 147th street. The meeting was in connection with a campaign to raise funds for the maintenance of the institute and its work. Senator Walsh said:

"I am very much interested in the Cardinal Gibbons School, first of all as an American, because the purpose of this school is to help to leadership men and women of this group that constitute millions of our population. The progress which our colored brethren have made in the last sixty years in America is astounding. In sixty years you have come up from slavery to a position of power, influence and standing in the community. 'It is a progress that has never been equaled in the history of the world by any race.'"

Other speakers were Mr. Thomas J. O'Keefe, Professor E. A. Clark of Washington, D. C.; Frederick R. Moore, editor of the "New York Age," who presided, and Victor H. Daniel, formerly of Tuskegee Institute, now the principal of the Cardinal Gibbons Institute. The institute has been open for classes since October, 1924. It began with thirteen pupils and now has sixty-five. A gift of 200 acres by the late Cardinal Gibbons provided it with a building site and a farm near Ridge, Maryland.

TIDE OF BATTLE IN NICARAGUA

Conservatives Give Ground Before Liberal Forces—American Marines Fired On

MASAYA, Nicaragua, March 22.—Police Chief Jose Corea today notified President Adolfo Diaz that a truckload of United States marines was fired on this morning from a nearby house. The bullets broke the windshield of the truck, but caused no casualties. The message said that marine officers, assisted by local officials, were investigating the shooting and were searching suspected places for arms. Masaya is about twenty miles from Managua.

MANAGUA, Nicaragua, March 22.—Fierce fighting is going on near Terra Azul, not far from Muy Muy, between Liberal and Conservative forces, the aviators, Lee Mason and William Brooks, who are attached to the Conservatives, reported tonight.

The aviators, who are Americans, estimated that there were 1,200 Liberals and 1,000 Conservatives. The Conservatives were giving ground in an attempt to gain better positions on the hillside, where they plan to await reinforcements en route from Muy Muy under General Salvador Reyes. The aviators said they dropped no bombs and were merely on an observation trip. They estimated that more than a score of men had been killed in the fighting.

(Continued from page 2) the press he said he came to study the situation, which he hoped would be settled soon. Immediately after his arrival he engaged in a long conference with the police of the French settlement.

French Evacuation Forecast A startling secret order whose entire significance is unknown was issued today when, shortly after a conference between Gen. Chiang and French police authorities, residents of the French concession were notified to be ready to evacuate their settlement and meet in special concentration points along the bund, this evacuation to be made on a prearranged signal.

More defensive emplacements have been constructed between the French concession and the remainder of the settlement. The French have permit-

ted many unarmed Cantonese soldiers to enter their concession. A meeting was held tonight between the French and other settlement authorities to try to arrange co-operative measures. There are persistent rumors that the Powers are not working together. Guards have been doubled at strategic points between the concession and the barricaded officer. In anticipation of trouble, it is expected to close all barricades immediately.

Japan Does Not Forget She Is of the Orient TOKIO, March 27.—Japan generally is maintaining calm with regard to the Chinese situation. The newspapers unanimously counsel prudence, caution and reserve, although urging protection of Japanese life in the affected areas and also insisting on payment for property damage and injuries to Japanese subjects.

The press is apparently echoing the stand-off attitude of the government, which reiterates that its policy is one of non-interference and sympathy toward China. It is generally believed that more than sporadic outrages would be necessary to provoke Japanese interference, as any warlike move against China would be deemed disastrous to future relations.

NEGROES WIN SCHOOL SUIT Court Finds Town Has No Authority To Lease Separate Building TOMIS RIVER, N. J., March 23.—Declaring that in his opinion the Dover Board of Education had no authority to lease a building in another township for the use of Negro children, Judge Harry E. Newman today found the parents not guilty of keeping their children from the Tomis River schools.

The decision was rendered following a rule to show cause why the Negro children should not attend a school selected by the Dover Board of Education. The Negroes refused to send their children to school, declaring the building selected was unfit for a school. The next move will be the arguing of a writ of mandamus issued against the Berkeley Township Board of Education, directing it to admit Robert Reason as a scholar in the Sayville schools, which order has not been obeyed. The case will come up April 6.

(Continued from page 6) and it is officially finished as far as I am concerned," he said. "Of course, when I take up the fight in the Senate again for Haitian independence I shall probably mention it to illustrate certain points, but I shall not ask for any investigation."

"The entire circumstances surrounding the exclusion show that it was an effort to keep alive the fiction of Haitian independence," he said, and added, "It has really served to focus the attention of Americans upon the domination by this government of Haitian affairs."

Attacks Government's Policy In terms similar to those which he has used in the past to attack the United States policy in Haiti, the Senator attacked what he termed the "imperialistic" policy there. He said that only a very small portion of the population supported President Borno and that, if American military domination ended, Mr. Borno would depart at once.

"But I am sure that within a year or two Haiti will be free of such domination and that public opinion there and here will force the granting of genuine independence," he said.

It Is To Laugh (From The Nation) Haiti, some of our readers will recall, was occupied by American marines in 1916, and the marines are still there. Haiti's customs houses are under American control, the constitution and budget are American-made, and her president, M. Louis Borno, is a pure American invention.
