We who love him have lived to hear rabid enemies sing his praises. We are seeing those who

We congratulate him upon his patience, his endurance, his fortitude in the face of a situation which has been repeated many times in the lives of great men; but a situation which is no less trying each time that it obtains. BARBECUE OUTING AS HATE KILLER IN DOLE GEORGIA

The Old, Old Story - They Neither Dined Nor Played Together, but Palsion Cason Spoke Behind the Back-to-the-Farm White Orators

A few weeks ago H. L. Mencken, a distinguished white writer, brought down upon his head a hail of wrath by saying in his column in the New York Sunday World that the common out of the Negro led by the pastor but moans. Barbecue for Negroes As Prop for Good Will WOODLAND, Ga., Aug. 12.—An outing designed to strengthen the bonds of unity and good will existing between the white citizens and Negroes here yesterday witnessed the attendance of several thousand persons of both races. The gathering was believed the first Negro home-coming ever given by white citizens.

President members of both races delivered addresses in evidencing the friendship of the two in this part of the State. The occasion was planned primarily that the people of Talbot County might manifest their appreciation of the loyalty and industry of the Negroes in this county, free of whom a beautiful barbecue was tendered to the Negroes after the speaking, followed by various athletic events, including a baseball game in which only the Negroes participated.

The principal speakers were H. A. Alsbrooks and John Highten, agricultural agents for railroad. Both men permitted the white citizens and Negroes here and urged continuation of greater farming activities, principally in dairy and poultry raising. He pointed out that the Negro family owning and operating farms in the South have become progressively poorer and have accumulated more money than those who have migrated.
