## Racial Affection Is Necessary to Racial Growth—Garvey

### Aged Negro Who Helped White Friend, Now a Millionaire, Gets a Life-Time Position

#### Friend in Need and Helped Walgreen to Regain Health

CHICAGO, OCT. 16.—Thirty years ago Charlie Morris cast bread upon the waters in the form of friendliness toward a down-and-out fellow workman. Today, conforming to the Biblical version as it should, the bread has returned in many fold. The fellow worker is now a multimillionaire, none other than Charles Walgreen, the drug store magnate, who has come to remember his friend.

Morris was a \$9-a-week porter in a drug store where Walgreen was an \$18-a-month clerk before the Spanish-American War of '98. The two became bosom pals but the war separated them. Morris sent Walgreen money and tobacco while he was off fighting in Cuba and when he returned from the battle front with his health wrecked and little hope for life, Morris took him into his wife's home, where they nursed him back to health. They again became separated and this time heard no more of each other for thirty years.

Morris in these years could make no headway against numerous adversities, but Walgreen had had the blessings of good fortune. Then fate took a hand.

Morris, jobless and desperate, saw an ad in the papers bearing the name Walgreen and he wondered if it could be his long lost friend. He journeyed to the busy office of the Walgreen Company and was seated inconspicuously in a corner when a stately looking man observed him.

"Isn't your name Morris?" he asked. "Sure enough, is, boss," said Charlie, and then: "Say, you ain't Charlie that used to work with me in a drug store before the war?"

"That's exactly who I am," Walgreen replied, and the spectators stared as the rich man grabbed the aged Morris and hugged him like a long lost brother. Charlie walked out of the reception room with a life-time job with his old pal.

### Harding Had Negro Blood Is Rumored

#### Dedication of Tomb of Late President Delayed by Resolution

MARION, O.—Dedication of the tomb of the late President Warren G. Harding, built in 1926, was postponed Monday by members of the Harding Memorial Association, who held their eighth annual meeting here.

The resolution to postpone the dedication plans was offered by former United States Attorney General Harry M. Daugherty, one of the sixteen members present at the meeting. The resolution read as follows:

"A belated dedication is not necessarily a reflection upon the dead, but a dedication grudgingly given is a compliment neither to the dead nor to those who participate in the ceremonies.

"Now, the American people, as a people, have never been swayed by the lip of libel or the tongue of slander and their devotion to his memory and their judgment of his merit is the final answer and appropriate reward to his labors.

"More than half a million people made their contributions to this beautiful monument."

#### Many Kulaks Migrate To North Manchuria

PEIPING.—Hundreds of "kulaks," better-to-do peasants from Soviet Russia, are migrating to North Manchuria because of the movement for collective farms, reports from Harbin said today.

These Russian farmers, among the most skillful of their class, are preparing to take out Chinese citizenship papers and find farms on which to settle permanently.

The kulaks already in Manchuria declare that thousands of others will follow their example, and report that the Soviet authorities do not favor their emigration. The Chinese officials encourage the Russians, on the other hand.

### Egypt Has New Constitution Against Wafd

#### More Trouble Ahead as Nationalists and Liberals Resist Gov't

According to press reports Egypt is in the throes of an impending revolution. The government is confronted with both Wafdist and liberal opposition.

All the main streets and large squares of Cairo are heavily guarded by mounted police, while the government offices, other public buildings and newspaper offices have troops stationed around them. These precautionary measures will be continued for some time, as the authorities fear outbreaks may occur within the next few days. The Wafdists continue unceasingly to threaten "to make any sacrifice to protect the rights, liberty and independence of the people," which they contend are trampled upon by the new constitution and electoral law.

The new Constitution and electoral law was signed yesterday by the King and promulgated this morning. The new Constitution has for its object the adaptation of the representative form of government to the present condition of Egypt.

The salient points of the Constitution as revised are: First, Egypt is a sovereign State, free and independent; second, the throne is hereditary to the descendants of Mohammed Ali; third, the Senate is to be composed of 100 members, sixty of whom will be appointed by the King, while the Chamber of Deputies is to consist of 150 elected members; fourth, elections will be according to a two-degree system, in the first degree of which the suffrage will be (Continued on Page Eight)

### White Man Wills Fortune to Woman

#### A Tribute to Faithful Service and Constant Help Through Many Years

BALTIMORE, Md.—It is not often that white men publicly and as a matter of record reward the Negroes who have served them faithfully, at least not to the extent of leaving any considerable portion of their estate to such Negroes. The exception became known to have occurred here recently when the last will and testament of Charles C. Herrell, secondhand furniture dealer, was filed for record in the Orphans' Court. By this will Harrell left his entire estate, reputed to be valued at several hundred thousand dollars, to Miss Aelina Fletcher, who had been a faithful servant and helper to him through many years.

The daughters of the dead man, and Mrs. Marion Harrell Brown of Miss Pauline Harrell of Atlanta, Ga., Washington, D. C., have served notice through their attorney, Harry W. Nica, that they intend to contest the will. Both the attorney and the daughters expressed themselves as being outraged to the insult which their father had heaped upon them in leaving his vast estate to a Negro. Attorneys for Miss Fletcher, however, state that under the laws of Maryland a man may leave his property to whom he wishes and that there is not the slightest chance of the will being broken.

#### Our Love for Each Other Should Be More Than Material Advantages — It Should Be a Kinship that is Spiritual, Befitting Man, Superior Creature

#### Whether We Be American Negroes, West Indian or African There is a Kinship that Binds Us—We Now Summon it to Service so that We May Go Forward to Our Destiny

FELLOWMEN OF THE NEGRO RACE, Greeting:

In this world of conflict and confusion, there is one thing that rises above our material outlook, and that is, the love that nature would have us show to each other.

**Superiority of Man**  
Man was not created as a common being, but as a superior creature, with feelings, passions and affections. Even in his savage state, he loves. It may be love in its crudeness, but the sentiment of his soul even though savage, expresses itself in true affection for mate or for companion. As man rises in the scale of civilization and culture, his affection becomes deeper and more pronounced.

**The Brotherhood**  
As of the individual, so of the race or the group that is by nature linked together. This superior feeling makes the brotherhood of man, because it suggests kinship in nature that is more than material—a kinship that is spiritual. Because we love, we should desire to do to each other as we would others should do to us, and if that is to be the practice of man, what a world of happiness we would have for ourselves, instead of a world of confusion and conflict. Henry George says:

"That we should do unto others as we would have them do unto us—that we should respect the rights of others as scrupulously as we would have our rights respected—is not a mere counsel of perfection to individuals, but it is the law to which we must conform social institutions and national policy, if we would secure the blessings and abundance of peace."

**Man's Well-Being**  
What greater suggestion for the well being of the common brotherhood could we have than this? Whether we be white, black or yellow this should be the supreme law, guiding us in our relationship racially and nationally. The absence of this in the world today is responsible for our chaos in politics, in industry, in commerce, in society, in all relationships that go to make up our boasted civilization.

**Show Love for Race**  
We are suggesting to the Negro to start out showing this love within his own ranks, to develop the sentiment of it and let each member of the race feel that he is not alone, but that he has the true affection of the four hundred million, who will live for him or die for him, as the case may be. Racial affection is necessary to racial growth; other races are succeeding today because of this affection and love, and there is no reason why the Negro should not go forward in practicing the same virtue.

**Our Destiny**  
Whether we be American Negro, West Indian or African, there is a kinship that binds us. It should be deep in affection and we now summon it to service so that in the relationship that exists we may go forward to our destiny, we may go forward embracing one aim and one GOD.

**Radio Program on Negro During Education Week**

The United States Office of Education, Department of Interior, is arranging a radio program to be broadcast over a national hook-up during the observance of American Education Week. This week is observed for the purpose of stimulating a widespread interest in our educational systems, and one of the broadcasting periods, which had been allotted to the general program will be used for the purpose of focusing the attention of the nation on some of the special educational problems which confront the Negro.

The radio program will consist of short addresses by national authorities, interspersed with music. It is understood that the details of the program will be announced later.

One of the problems which is considered of vital importance and which was revealed in a study made recently by the specialist in Negro education, grows out of the small percentage of Negroes enrolled in high school. This study which comprised sixteen southern states showed that only 3.7 per cent of the total Negro school enrollment were in high school in 1927-28, while the percentage for whites was 14.8. Figures were also released in this connection showing the comparison of Negro boys and girls enrolled in high school. Sixty-three per cent more Negro girls than boys attended high school in 1927-28, while the difference between white girls and boys was only seven per cent, in favor of the girls.

Many persons, while encouraged over the 178 per cent increase in the total Negro high school enrollment during the past ten years, and the 529 per cent increase in the fourth year of high school, lament the fact that so few Negro boys are continuing in school. It is expected that the devotion of an hour over a national hook-up to these and similar problems will do much to stimulate more interest in the educational needs of the Negro.

### Future of Negro Business Depends on Race's Loyalty; Segregation Biggest Asset

#### Jobless Aliens "Work" U.S. For Free Trip Home Must Be on Watch for White Competition to "Cut In"

ST. ALBANS, Vt. Aliens who are out of work in Canada have discovered an easy way to get back to the fatherland, wherever it is. They just get Uncle Sam to pay their fare.

Chief Inspector J. A. Trudell said today that the United States immigration officials were faced with a new problem as a result of unemployment conditions in Canada.

The game, he says, is for aliens to walk across the United States border and demand that they be arrested and deported to immigration laws, they must be deported to their country of origin and the United States has to pay their passage.

This is true in the very nature of things according to Marshall. Such success as the Negro has attained has come largely through a set of circumstances which tended to break the vicious circle. In Negro business this principle is abundantly illustrated. Such progress as the Negro business has made has been due in large measure to its segregated nature. Insurance is a case in point. Had there not been segregation in insurance, it is doubtful if Negro insurance could have survived. Behind almost all of the larger Negro fortunes is this same principle of segregation.

The phenomenal fortune of the late Madam Walker and of Mrs. Malone can be accounted for upon this principle of segregation. The wealth of our professional class under this same explanation. The Negro has achieved most wonderfully in those segregated fields in which he had a monopoly; he had a monopoly because of race prejudice; race prejudice therefore and the segregation that followed broke the Negro's vicious circle. If there were some way in which all Negro business could be segregated, Negro business would flourish. It is about time that the enterprising white business man is attempting in a hundred ways to get out of such segregation as is associated with a considerable trade. ### Ethiopia Bids Welcome to 1st Foreign Guests

#### American Envoy Presents President's Friendly Message to His Majesty

ADDIS ABABA, Abyssinia, Oct. 25. To the booming salute of seven brass guns, H. Murray Jacoby, special ambassador of the United States for the coronation of the Emperor Haile Selassie, today presented to His Majesty the greetings of President Hoover.

Mr. Jacoby conveyed to the ruler of one of the world's most ancient kingdoms the President's "most friendly greetings and confident hope for the great prosperity of Ethiopia and the happiness of its people under the benign reign of Haile Selassie."

The emperor thanked Mr. Jacoby and then, speaking in the Ethiopian language, said with great earnestness: "Your safe arrival in Ethiopia affords us much pleasure. We beg you to convey our best wishes to the President of the United States, his family and the American people."

Mr. Jacoby then presented Brig. Gen. W. W. Hayes and the members of his official party and all departed pleasantly with the emperor. During the audience, held in the throne room, there were present the emperor, prince and a number of other distinguished persons, including Prince Justin of Tera, designated by the emperor as viceroy of the southern part of the empire.

The emperor's reception to the Americans had special significance because they were the first delegation to be received officially.

### Once a Sleeping Car Porter Now a Ph.D.

#### Abraham Harris Becomes First Member of Race to Earn a Doctorate in Economics

Announcement was made last week that Professor Abraham Harris, acting head of the economic department of Howard University, Washington, D. C., had completed the required work for a doctorate in economics at Columbia University.

**First to Get Degree**  
According to Eugene Kinckle Jones, executive secretary of the National Urban League, Dr. Harris is the first Negro to earn the degree. Professor Edwin Seligman, head of the Columbia Economics Department, in an address recently, praised Dr. Harris highly. The degree will be formally awarded next February.

**Made A Climb**  
Dr. Harris was born 21 years ago at Richmond, Va., and rose to his present post after working as a sleeping car porter, shipyard worker and, earlier in life, as a butcher's errand boy. In 1925 he was a fellow of the Columbia U. Council for Research in the Social Sciences.

His doctor's thesis is a study of the Negro worker in the American labor movement, prepared in collaboration with Dr. Sterling D. Spero. Dr. Harris also has published works on "The Black Man in This Economic World" and "The Negro Population in Minneapolis" and is a frequent contributor to Current History and other periodicals.

**History as Taught is Largely Propaganda—Race's Indifference Attacked**

PHILADELPHIA, Pa.—The white attitude of the country is being attacked by a group of Negroes who are about to vote to tell the truth, said Miss Ruth Wagoner, white of the South Philadelphia high school for girls, last of the city school committee of the Friends Yearling House, last Saturday. Miss Wagoner spoke of the growing practice of segregation in the public schools of Philadelphia and said: "It seems to me that colored children should be taught with the whites."

HON. MARCUS GARVEY delivered recently at Kingston, Jamaica, British West Indies, an inspiring speech in defense of the poor working classes of the island. As usual Mr. Garvey preferred to speak by the oppressed and did not hesitate to attack and show up the oppressors and tyrants. He rejoices in fighting.

While Mr. Garvey was investigating the plight of the unemployed workers of the island preferred to sit with his eyes closed. When his attention was drawn to the serious situation the only thing the Governor would say was that he did not believe in it!

The autocrats have a curious psychology. They will be sending and hunting sedition day and night but blind to the causes that give rise to sedition. "Life," said he, "was intended not to be a continuous round of misery, but at least a season of happiness, and we may add even pleasure. The Creator made the world and made man to inherit all that there is in the world. But what pleasure is there in inheriting all that there is in the world to be driven away from his kind and kin to suffer and die in a foreign country while a few heartless and un-sympathetic enjoy the benefits of the land?"

The Negro workers of Jamaica have to be congratulated for having such a fearless leader as Mr. Garvey to champion their cause. He is interested as much in local and national affairs as he is in international affairs. No suffering, no tyranny will escape his attention and go unchallenged.

Neither the Jews nor the Arabs ever occupied her attention. It is sad to see that the Arabs and the Jews as pawns of the politics of British imperialism.

Now that the British Government and the Labor Government at that time favored the Jews as well as Arabs let the Zionist leaders stop talking about the "good intentions" of the British people as opposed to government. ## BRITISH DEPENDENCIES IN AFRICA

The territories: Consists of a number of colonies, protectorates, territories, provinces, islands and groups of islands, Northern and Southern Rhodesia, the self-governing Union of South Africa. The last and the independent kingdom of Egypt are described under their own headings.

Government: Constitution of British Empire is largely unwritten, but administration is based on three principles: self-government, where ever and whenever practicable, self-support and self-defense. The dependencies in Africa, apart from the self-governing Union of South Africa, are administered:

1. By a legislative assembly, partly or entirely elected, and an executive council nominated by the crown, e. g. Mauritius.

2. By a governor with executive and (or) legislative councils nominated by the crown, e. g. Gambia, Sierra Leone, Gold Coast, Seychelles.

3. By a governor alone, e. g. St. Helena, Bechuanaland, Basutoland.

4. By governor or commissioners under the colonial office with nominated advisory or executive councils, e. g. Nigeria, Kenya, Tanganyika, Uganda, Zanzibar, Nyasaland, Somaliland.

In the protectorates and colonies native kings and chiefs are encouraged to govern their own people, and native laws and customs are respected, unless they conflict with justice or morality. The chartered company which, until recently, controlled the administration of Rhodesia, has been relieved of its obligations. Northern Rhodesia has been constituted a crown colony, while Southern Rhodesia has been granted responsible government.

Anglo-Egyptian Sudan: Consists of fifteen provinces under military government. Area about 1,014,000 square miles. Principal source of world supply of gum and arabic and ivory. Cotton growing important. Principal towns: Khartoum, the capital; Omdurman, Merou, Suakin, El-Obeid and Port Sudan.

Ascension Island in South Atlantic, a dependency of the colony of St. Helena. Area, 34 square miles. Garrison station. Georgetown. Basutoland (territory): Area about 11,716 square miles. Produces cattle, wheat, maize, mohair, and Kaffir corn, (cotton, Maseru). Bechuanaland (territory): Area about 275,000 square miles. Administered by Union of South Africa. Cattle raising is principal industry. Headquarters of administration at Mafeking. Cape Province. Principal towns: Serowe, Francistown.

Cameron (mandated territory): Formerly German protectorate: Area 191,300 square miles, divided into French and British spheres. British sphere, a strip of 28,000 square miles, on Nigerian eastern border. Rich in forest produce. Capital, Bua.

Gambia (colony and protectorate): Area of colony proper, St. Mary Island, four square miles. Protectorate, 4,500 square miles. Capital, Bathurst.

## Race Loyalty Needed for Negro Business Growth

(Continued from Page One)

Negro business is in a vicious circle. It cannot compete because of a lack of capital, and it lacks capital because it cannot compete. The tendency is not for this condition to be relieved, but for it to become more aggravated. The problem for Negro business is to break this vicious circle.

Race loyalty offers the main source of hope. Those Negroes who hold that the Negro business man must measure up to the best white business before he need expect the Negro's patronage are speaking beside the point; and what is more, they are asking the Negro to lift himself by his bootstraps. Because of the long start which white business has had over Negro business and with greater capital accumulations, it is simply impossible for the Negro business man to meet the white business man on equal terms and survive.

Even cooperation on a strictly business basis will not do it. Even our chain stores in a "cut throat" trade war could not survive unless Negroes supported them from racial reasons.

"Appreciation trade" then offers the only hope for Negro business in its initial stages. Those who oppose "appreciation trade" do so largely from a fault of reasoning. It is true that Negro business cannot be built upon appreciation trade, it is true that though it can be begun with it! A good beginning is what the Negro business needs. Whoever expects Negro business in its initial stages to compete on equal terms with white business of long development and large capital accumulations commits Negro business to doom. There is no remunerative business that is not segregated in nature, in which a Negro might engage, in which the white capitalists may not drive him to the wall. Even if Negroes had all the business receiving a volume ten times its own. "Appreciation trade" then is the key to Negro business development and this is true whether we admit it or not. It is the only way to break the race's vicious economic circle in business.

Let us say that Negro business passes through three stages, namely, the segregated stage when segregation breaks the vicious circle; the "appreciation trade" stage when Negro business must depend upon that trade that comes by reason of Negro loyalty to race enterprise; the final stage, the economic, when the Negro business can give the money's worth, as at the final stage and must be arrived at via the other two. There is, of course, the danger that if Negroes give Negro business "appreciation trade" we are doomed so far as efficient service is concerned. This will be true only so long as men "take up" business but not one day longer. When our institutions turn out men and women trained in business and business principles, more and more we may expect to see full advantage taken of "appreciation trade" not as a final stage in our business progress but as a stepping stone to the very highest business efficiency. The hope for Negro business is at present in "appreciation trade" and the hope that "appreciation trade" will fulfill its purpose is in trained Negro business men and women.

## 15 Injured in Bombay As Police Charge Mob

Crowd Was Celebrating Arrest of Pandit Nehru—Plece Goods Dealers Suspend Business

BOMBAY, Oct. 31.—Fifteen persons were injured, three seriously, when police charged into a crowd of demonstrators on the Chaurai Sands today, breaking up a celebration to congratulate the civil disobedience leader Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru on his release from prison.

A prohibition had been placed upon such meetings. When the crowd refused to disperse, the police charged with their staves. Several arrests were made. Among the prisoners were the vice president of the All-India National Congress "War Council" and head of the Nationalist militia.

The Association of Native Piece Goods Merchants today declared a cessation of business for an indefinite period. The order rescinded one of Oct. 13 which had permitted members to open their shops for the purpose of disposing of foreign cloth stocks.

Today's action also enjoined shopkeepers from purchasing any new stocks of foreign cloths.

## Brave Negro Saves Train

Stops Runaway Engine Dashing in Direction of Oncoming Freight

YAZOO CITY, Miss., Oct. 16.—The alertness of Jim Lunsday, colored engine coaler in the local Y. and M. V. railroad yards, probably avoided a fatal train wreck Sunday night when two white men stole a switch engine and started north from the yards. Several persons saw the men get off the speeding engine and reported it to Lindsay, who immediately got into another engine, fired up and threw the throttle wide open, hurling the iron monster on in wild pursuit of the run-away engine.

Lindsay overtook the engine five miles from town and by some movie acrobatics managed to board and stop it just in time to flag a fast freight coming from the opposite direction on the same track. He was warmly commended for his courage.

## Negro History Ignored Even by Race Leaders

because, in a large measure, the Negroes themselves do not care for it. "History is largely propaganda, and the Negro is a poor propagandist," he continued.

Scoring the attitude of apparent contempt for Negro history on the part of Negro school teachers, he added: "Negroes are opposed to teaching Negro history because they feel that it will invite attention to the fact that they're Negroes."

"Nobody has told the story of the Negro and his tremendous influence on American life. In the South a Negro principal, were he to suggest Negro history be added to the school curriculum, would be dismissed."

"If you teach a Negro that he has had a history worth while pretty soon he'll feel he's just as good as the white man, and then you'll have a lynching."

He observed, however, that a few private schools in the South and a few county schools were gradually using text books on the Negro.

"George Washington would not have been possible had it not been for the fact that three or four thousand Negroes followed him in the battle for independence. George Washington slept on the same blanket with his body servant James, a Negro," he continued.

Dr. Henry T. Hodgkin, director of Pindie Hill School, Wallingford, Pa., stressed the sympathetic attitude necessary on the part of a teacher.

"A teacher of history must bring to the classroom a reverence for all men. The teacher must appreciate the fact that he or she has just as much to be ashamed of or proud of as any other member of the human race. The teacher must have an innate respect for all groups, and must have the courage to face the facts of history," he said.

The conference was held under the auspices of the American Interracial Peace Committee, Alice Dunbar Nelson, executive secretary.

Teachers and principals were present from Washington, D. C., Wilmington, Del., Atlantic City, N. J., Baltimore, Md., Trenton, N. J., Harrisburg, Pa., Carlisle, Pa., Cheyney Training School for Teachers and West Chester, Pa.

Other speakers on the program were Montgomery Gregory, Miss Marie Chase, Dr. Stuart Rice, Mrs. Rachel Davis DuBois, George A. Johnson and Dr. W. E. B. DuBois, editor of the Crisis, New York City.

## Negro Vet to Dine With Pres. Hoover

WASHINGTON. — Representing this city at the National American Legion Convention, which is being held in Boston, Massachusetts, from Monday to Thursday of this week will be the only living Negro ex-soldier possessor of the Congressional Medal of Honor, the highest military honor in America.

Veteran of 3 Wars George H. Wanton, 65 years of age, veteran of the Spanish-American War, the Philippine Insurrection, and the World War, left Washington on the Federal Express, Saturday night, to participate in the celebration, the first in which the 68 living recipients of the Medal of Honor have been assembled since the burying of the Unknown Soldier, shortly after the close of the World War. Mr. Wanton saw service in the Tenth U. S. Cavalry.

The only colored man who boasts of the same medal that bestowed on Colonel Charles Lindbergh and Commander Richard Byrd, is in possession of invitations to the ceremony, signed by city officials. He is to be a guest of honor of the city of Cambridge.

## Dine With Hoover

On Monday, October 6, Mr. Wanton was in attendance at a special dinner at which President Herbert Hoover was the honored guest. This is the first occasion that a Negro has dined with the President of the United States since early in the twentieth century when Booker T. Washington broke fast with the late President Theodore Roosevelt.

## Gasoline Gushes from Race Man's Well

REIDSVILLE, N. C. — Lonnie Burwell, a Negro farmer down in the south-eastern section of Caswell County, has refused \$10,000 for 16 acres of land since a well dug on his place thirty years ago has become an oil well following blasting by the State Highway Commission some nine months ago.

After the blasting, Burwell found that oil was in the well with the water, but the water finally disappeared and now he is drawing out four gallons of pure high test gasoline every day. He has drawn more than 400 gallons since last February.

W. M. Allen, State food and oil chemist, reports the gasoline to be of high test, and the government laboratory at Washington reports it as having tested 61 per cent, the highest test of any yet found in the United States.

Burwell has accepted a lease proposition from P. E. Harnelson of Corbett, and J. M. Ivey of Graham, whereby he is to receive half of the proceeds derived from sale of the gasoline. The lessees have an additional 390 acres adjacent to Burwell's land, and are arranging to start immediately the deep drill of a well.
