He was to lay a wreath on the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier last night, but State Department officials tried to arrange for him to have the meal with officers at the post.

But when cooks at the post were told that for religious reasons Ras Demtu touches no meat, milk and butter on Wednesdays and Fridays they threw up their hands and asked to be excused.

The job of preparing a meal fit for royalty on short notice without meat, milk and butter was beyond their skill. So the Ethiopian mission returned to its Washington hotel.

En route to the cemetery the Ambassador received royal honors, a 21-gun salute by the Sixteenth Cavalry as he passed the White House.

NAT'L ORGANIZING COMMITTEE, U. S. CONGRESS AGAINST WAR REPORTS RESPONSE

60 National Organizations Join to Support Congress Against War

New York.—Responding to a call for a United States Congress Against War sponsored by Sherwood Anderson, Theodore Dreiser and Upton Sinclair, over 60 national organizations in the field of labor, farmers, war veterans, unemployed, student, Negro racial groups, journalists and professions, including the leading Publishers, Communist, Socialists and Liberal organizations joined into a national organizing committee for a united front anti-war gathering in New York September 24, to support a program of struggle against the danger of a new war which the call says is especially acute at this time, said a statement issued today by Donald Henderson, former Columbia University instructor, secretary of the A.
