

Ministers Rebuke Prejudiced Treasury Official Roberts

Condemn His Radio Speech as Insult Disguised as Humor-Daily Raps Georgia "Statesman"

Washington, D. C.—It is rumored here that there is much displeasure in official circles due to the insulting radio address delivered by Asst. Secretary Roberts of the Treasury Department last week. Many argue that it will react unfavorably on the political complexion of the next Congress should these Southern pseudo Statesmen insist on making Radio addresses before they are censured.

In a despatch to the "Daily N. X. Mirror," The Correspondent writes:

There is at least one high official whose future radio remarks will be scrupulously censored in advance. The occasion was a festive one. It was the Victory Day celebration of the 1918-1919 war. The speaker was Mr. Roberts, assistant secretary of the Treasury Department. He began his first story. It was a treatise in "fast thinking" on an implied compliment to young Mr. Joseph Crum, the youth who led the Griffs to victory. Roberts said: "It reminds me of the story of the darky down a draw-gate. As the narrative waxed fast, somebody yelled from the audience, 'Hey! You're on the air!'"

"Don't kid yourself," was Mr. Roberts' part rejoinder. This is just a family party. We all aren't on the air!"

A goosepimp radio audience, however strained its ears, to catch further morsels.

"And Ah am also reminded of a story," continued the irresponsibly young voice of the old speaker.

Mr. Roberts went on about the oldest center figure who had to chase a sure-ho when he got there.

Once again the radio went dead. This time it did not resume until a new speaker was addressing the Victory banquet.

Dear Sir:

The Inter-Departmental Ministers' Alliance of Washington and vicinity, representing 141 churches, and church-going public of more than 80,000 in Washington, desire to call your attention to the speech on the occasion of the testimonial banquet tendered to the Washington football team last Monday evening.

Ministers of the Alliance, and a large number of patriots of the broadest sympathies, heard this speech, in which you deliberately included a number of unvetted and insulting references.

These insults, inappropriate and unbecomingly detracted from the dignity of the citizens of every race in the community share with a high sense of civic pride and patriotism.

We on our own behalf, resent these insults, as well as on behalf of an intelligent, decent, and justifying part of the community, and of such of the citizenry in our whole country.

Already, members of the local community have protested to their ministers against your remarks, which are outraged, as they rightly feel, the proprieties, dignities, and decencies of 32,000,000 citizens in the country, of 1,000 citizens in Washington, of a large number of American citizens of other races.

A delegation of prominent churchmen and citizens met at the 1212 Street Y. M. C. A., Wednesday morning, forming a protest and carried it to Roberts' person.

against certain types of armaments or weapons; that we are not simply opposing certain methods and styles of murder but are opposing murder, says Wm. Pickens, Field Secretary of National Association for the Advancement of Colored People.

"You perhaps expect me to say something about the Negro one among those who have all to lose and nothing to gain thru modern war. The World War proved that an oppressed people can expect as the fruits of war only more oppression. With honours proclaimed to the victors, and the profit of manufacturers and colonies. Millions of blacks from the East Indies and Africa, North America and Africa, fought bravely and loyally on the side of victory, and today India and Liberia are still struggling for self-government and the Negroes of the Mississippi Valley are being disfranchised and disinherited as they were in 1913.

Unless their enforcement is part of the Government's scheme for the relief of the distress among the Africans, it is no earthly reason why these oppressive laws should not be abolished or at least suspended until the depression has passed and the country has returned to its normal life.

The modification of these laws, which are a disgrace to any Christian and civilized community, has been again and again urged by commissions appointed by the Government after taking evidence from both white and black, and the Native Affairs Department, who were never cheered before. The surviving Negro soldier, returning from France, met bigotry, reviled, trampled upon, and a terror of "race riots" stalking thru the land. In some instances he was frankly told that the sooner he got out of his uniform and forgot that he had been a soldier of democracy, the better it would be for him. In other instances his uniform and decorations were literally torn from his body by those whom the very victory which he had helped to achieve now made more confident of their power to oppress him. The only independent Negro country in the Western world had been seized and its government overturned by the white soldiers of the United States. This black soldier was upholding the flag on foreign soil. All the people of the world should be appalled by this, but especially the United States, which is the land of the free and the home of the brave.

(Special to The Negro World) JOHANNESBURG, South Africa—Councillor R. Dunlop of Marburg, replying to a paper read by Councillor Saul Rutowitz at Pretoria, at the annual conference of the National Association of Managers and Superintendents of Urban Natives in session here, caused quite a sensation by his forceful denunciation of the policy of the European towards fellow countrymen. "Natives can no longer be kept in their place," said Mr. Dunlop. "We have to get rid of the idea that the European could stand alone and legislate for the Black Man and say: 'This is your place and you are going to cross that line.' Time has gone by.

"The whole future of civilization in South Africa is going to be based on a broad right-of-view—that the Black Man must be given an opportunity to show his place in civilization. They are not going to do it by any method of class segregation."

Councillor Rutowitz, who is a staunch supporter of repatriation of natives to Urban centers, is meeting with stubborn opposition from the local press and civic leaders.

It is the consensus of opinion that the complete urbanization of the natives in the native townships and native villages will open up further problems for urban councils who are responsible for their accommodation. The problem of food and shelter, it is cited, will increase as the year goes on.

ATLANTA NEGROES PROTEST POLICE BRUTALITY

Church Surrounded By Police With Machine Guns and Tear Gas Bombs—Minister Petition Wrote of Omnipotence

(Staff Correspondence) ATLANTA, Ga.—This city is seething with excitement because of the slaying of Grover Davis, a colored man, by the police a few days ago. The United Provisional Committee, composed of leading business and professional men, are protesting to the Mayor and other leading citizens to stop this brutal and reckless slaying of innocent citizens by the Atlanta Police Department. This committee sets forth a number of instances of police persecution of innocent race men and women in Atlanta, and further states that it is practically unsafe for a citizen to petition the proper authorities for redress.

The culmination of this civic unrest took place at a "Protest Funeral" last week at the Mt. Zion Baptist Church, which the Rev. Dunaway is pastor. Long before the doors of the church opened crowds jammed every block. It is estimated that more than four thousand people came to lend their aid in the fight to mould public sentiment against the continued cruelties and injustices practiced against the Negroes of Atlanta. Seeing that the crowd was not to be deterred in their determination to seek redress, the pastor tried to call off the meeting; but with no success—despite the presence of mounted police with machine guns and tear gas bombs.

This change greatly disappointed the people and it remained for Dr. J. A. Martin of the C. L. L. Church to emerge the hero of the occasion. His prayer will ever remain one of the most illustrious and important on the pages of American history. Here is what he said:

"Lord, give us men who are not afraid to speak against and denounce police brutality, and their slaying Negroes, shooting

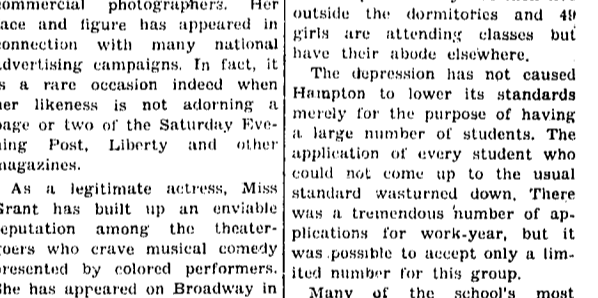
